



Louvre Abu Dhabi is open to the Public!

Louvre Abu Dhabi opened its doors to the public on 11 November 2017. It is the first museum of its kind in the Arab world: a universal museum that focuses on shared human stories across civilizations and cultures.

Located in Abu Dhabi, the capital of the United Arab Emirates (UAE), Pritzker Prize winning French architect Jean Nouvel has designed a museum city (Arab medina) under a vast silvery dome. Visitors can walk through the promenades overlooking the sea beneath the museum's 180-metre dome, comprised of almost 8,000 unique metal stars set in a complex geometric pattern. When sunlight filters through, it creates a moving 'rain of light' beneath the dome, reminiscent of the overlapping palm trees in the UAE's oases.

On display will be the museum's important collection of artworks, artefacts and loans from France's top museums. These span the entirety of human existence: from prehistorical objects to commissioned contemporary artworks, highlighting universal themes and ideas and marking a departure from traditional museography that often separates according to origin. In addition to the galleries, the museum will include exhibitions, a Children's Museum, a restaurant, a boutique and a café.

Louvre Abu Dhabi forms one element of Abu Dhabi's cultural strategy, which safeguards our rich heritage and catalyses creativity. Investment in a vibrant cultural ecosystem supports the UAE's economic diversification and development as a modern, dynamic society. Louvre Abu Dhabi will inspire a new generation of cultural leaders and creative thinkers to contribute to our rapidly-changing and tolerant nation."

The intergovernmental agreement includes the loan of the Musée du Louvre's name for 30 years and 6 months, temporary exhibitions for 15 years, and loans of artworks for 10 years.

Tickets for the museum will cost 60 AED for general admission and 30 AED for ages between 13 and 22, as well as UAE education professionals. Free entry will apply to members of the museum's loyalty program, children under 13 years, ICOM or ICOMOS members, journalists, and visitors with special needs (referred to visitors with determination in the UAE) as well as their companion.







AFGHANISTAN CHINA COOPERATION AGREEMENTS

AFGHANISTAN MINISTRY OF FINANCE 04 Dec 2017: The 3rd Joint Economic and Trade Commission between Afghanistan and China was co-chaired by H.E. Eklil Hakimi, Minister of Finance and Ms. Gao Yan, Vice Minister of Commerce of the People's Republic of China in Beijing.

In this meetings, they discussed on strengthening bilateral economic and transit cooperation, Afghanistan's membership in the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB), Afghanistan's position in the Silk Road Economic Belt, Encouraging China's Investors to Invest in Afghanistan, Development of air connection between the two countries, Raise Afghanistan's exports to the agriculture sector, Chinese companies investing in infrastructure and development projects, Reducing customs tariffs on Afghanistan's exports of goods to China and the exchange of customs information and railway of five countries (Afghanistan, Iran, Tajikistan, Kyrgyzstan and China).

In this meeting, China's cooperation in renewable energy sectors, transport and water resources management, visa problems of Afghan traders, Afghanistan's participation in the Chinese exportation exhibition in 2018, regional cooperation, gas transportation from Turkmenistan to China through Afghanistan, transportation and connection of fiber optics through the Wakhan Corridor, Railroad Institute, affordable housing construction, textile industry, Cement Factory, Aynak Copper and Amu Darya Projects, Marble, Pine Nuts and Pomegranate export to China and other important issues were also taken into consideration.

Meanwhile, the Chinese side assured its continued support, it was decided to provide to it comprehensive package of projects based on the needs and priorities of Afghanistan for the next 5 years.

Minister of Finance has also signed two Agreements with the Deputy Minister of Commerce for the new facilities of Char Chenar Palace in ARG, equipment for the Jamhuriat Hospital and China Aid Office Supplies for the Ministry of Refugees and Repatriations.

Minister of Finance thanked to the cooperation China and its hospitality.

It is worth mentioning that, on the sidelines of the 3rd Joint Economic and Trade Commission, Minister of Finance and Mr. Jin Liqun, the president of AIIB discussed regarding the imminent visit of the Bank's preliminary team for financing Afghanistan infrastructure projects.
